Appearance

Jewellery	Jewellery is not allowed except for a watch and one pair of small studs, but not dangling or hooped earrings. It is advisable that ears are pierced at the start of the Summer holiday. (Please remember that pierced ears in school can be dangerous). NO jewellery is allowed to be worn during PE activities for safety reasons.
Make-Up	Children are not allowed to wear any type of make-up in school (even on mufti days), this includes nail varnish and in particular false or acrylic nails. Children will be asked to remove all make-up.
Hair Styles	We do like our children to be individual, however in keeping with a positive image and representing the school, hair styles should be of a sensible nature. We do not allow patterns in hair, extreme cuts or hair extensions. Bows worn should be yellow or green.

Mobile Phones

The school do not allow children to bring mobile phones onto school premises unless they are Year 6 pupils. Permissions must be sought from the Head Teacher for Year 6 pupils to have phones. Forms available from the school office. All phones will be locked in the classroom safe during the day and children will be allowed to collect them at the end of the day.
