Queen Victoria Primary School



The Learning Hub at Queen Victoria Primary School is committed to providing specialist education. Our staff are dedicated to identifying the particular needs of all children and provide intensive support to overcome barriers to a child learning. The children that access the Learning Hub have EHCP's or other complex needs. We work on individual targets based on advice from Speech and Language Therapists, Occupational Therapists and our Learning Support Specialist Teacher to engage all children and ensure the provision enables progress. Our Learning Hub consists of a small group of approximately seven SEND pupils from Year I up to Year 3, with a ratio of 2:7, which runs every Thursday 9-IIam and Friday from 9-I2pm.

Our Learning Hub is a place of structured and incidental learning, which promotes life skills and provides embedded experiential learning. All children follow a clear visual routine, which includes: developing respect for all, empathy, sharing food, social skills, group discussion times, listening and communicating, individualised work tasks, shared play as well as specialised programmes, grounded in consistency, positive reinforcement, and praise. We use individual ECHP's to structure sessions and support the holistic needs of our children, considering their interests to support active engagement and maintaining focus. We also work in partnership with Parents/Carers, Class teachers and other professionals to enable a consistent approach.
