English

This half term we will be exploring the narrative 'George and the Dragon' and creating our own new adventure storu.

We will also be reading 'The Owl who was afraid of the dark'. We will use this text and delve deeper into the vocabulary that is used, use our prediction skills and answer questions using our inference, retrieval and explanation skills. We will be continuing to develop our reading skills during our daily reading sessions.

Music

Musical Me: In this topic we will learn to sing the song 'Once a Man Fell in a Well' and to play it using tuned percussion, adding sound effects, experimenting with timbre and dynamics, and using letter notation to write a melodu.

Jigsaw (PHSE)

This half term is all about Dreams and Goals! We will be looking at what dreams are realistic and how we can work together to achieve them. We will be looking at these through a variety of activities during our weekly Jigsaw lessons.
