English

This half term we will be focusing on the text 'Stone Age Boy' By Satoshi Kitamura.

Children will learn how to:

- Use a variety of different conjunctions to extend their sentences.
- Use an expanded set of adjectives to add description.
- Use a complex sentence correctly
- Use direct speech with a story to show when a character is speaking.



Maths

This half term we will be focusing on Number.

Children will learn the skills of:

- Adding and subtracting 2 numbers including going across tens and hundreds, using the column method, but still using manipulatives to support the learning.
- Multiplication, we will be identifying groups and sets of numbers and using arrays.
- Division, we will looking at sharing numbers into equal sets and how division is the inverse of multiplication.

History

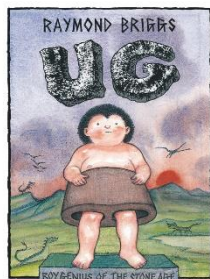
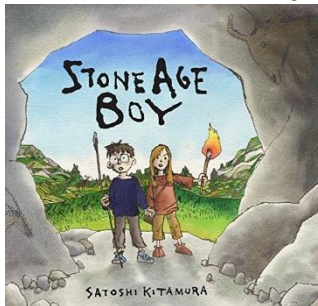
In History this half-term we are going to be learning about the period of time known as 'The Stone Age to the Iron Age'.

We will be learning all about –

'What was new about the Stone Age?'

'What was better, Bronze or Iron?'

'When do you think it was better to live – Stone Age, Bronze Age or Iron Age?'
