Maths

This half term we will be focusing on Number and Fractions. Children will learn the skills of:

- Number: Multiplication and Division, focusing on formal written methods, identify multiples and factors, and common factors of two numbers, prime numbers, prime factors and composite (non-prime) numbers, square and cubed numbers.
- Fractions: Comparing and ordering fractions adding and subtracting fractions with the same and then different denominators.

RF

This half term the children will be focusing on the question 'What can we learn from religious texts?' Children will make links between religious stories and look at the use of prayers in different religions.

PSHE

Our focus will be on 'Celebrating Differences between different cultures. We will discuss how differences can sometimes cause conflict but how all differences should be respected. We will also develop a range of strategies in managing feelings and responses linked to bullying.

DT

We will be investigating and making frame structures. We will be learning to use tools appropriately as well as creating designs, making structures and evaluating its effectiveness.

History

English

We will start this half term looking at how to write a Biography, using the

Biography of Cleopatra as a guide to help us write about Tutankhamun,

Howard Carter and Hatshepsut. Leading up to Christmas, we will then be

busy writing a narrative story based on Raymond Brigg's 'The Snowman'.

Reading: We will be using a range of other texts to:

Develop inference skills (reading between the lines)

Welcome Back

In History this half term we will begin thinking about the achievements of the Ancient Egyptians We will be learning about When Ancient Egypt was and how long it existed. Why the Nile was important to the creation of the Egyptian civilisation and how agricultural advances supported them. Why the role of scribe and the afterlife were so important in Egyptian society as well as about where the mummified bodies were placed.

Science

We will be investigating different forces allowing children the opportunity to explore: Why is the force of gravity important, how are different objects affected by air resistance, how levers, pulleys and gears work and how ground friction affects objects.

Music

We will be learning about 'Blues' music, including the history of Blues music, playing a chord, the 12-bar blues, blues scale and finally improvisation and the Blues

ART

Our focus will be on Colour, The form of Art will be studying is: Painting. The medium we will be using will be mixed media. We will do all of this by studying a variety of artists looking at colour theory, mood and feeling.
